At this year's League of Women Voters of the United States (LWVUS) convention from June 28-July 1, a *Transformational Roadmap* for moving the national League forward into its second century will be reviewed and discussed. This roadmap will be used for a "transformational journey" that will ensure the League remains strong, visible, and relevant.

While on this journey, the following key League elements will not change: Mission impact work. Nonpartisanship. Membership organization.

The focus of the journey will be on four priorities designed to move the national organization forward:

- 1. Advance a clear strategic focus.
- 2. Build a more inclusive culture.
- 3. Build a healthier League network.
- 4. Increase capacity at all levels.

As we learn more about the *Transformational Roadmap* the LWVUS has presented, we as a local League will need and want to explore the four priorities to determine the path for our own "transformational journey".

#### PEORIA COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION, Tuesday, June 5

The Election Commission held its monthly meeting on June 5, with all commissioners present. They approved payment of bills, even though monthly bills for American Water, and the copier had not yet arrived. This was due to the early meeting date (the first Tuesday rather than the second).

Executive Director Tom Bride gave an update on the Brandywine location. He stops by several times a week to check on progress. Currently, they seem to be on schedule for a September 1 move-in date. Metal studs and door framing are up, and electrical and fire alarm work is being completed. Bride's attendance has been helpful because an error was discovered in the placement of a wall. The wall would have run into a window, so it was moved slightly.

Bride will also put out a Request For Proposal (RFP) for software and/or hardware for the ePollbooks. The current software will not be supported after the fall election. He hopes new software will work on the current poll books. He is looking for a three year contract.


